



The four islands of Islamorada are a linear treasure trove of unique shops and galleries. You'll be mesmerized by wood carvings, fused glass, fine oils and acrylics in Islamorada's galleries featuring the works of our local island artists as well as a world class selection of outstanding boutiques and jewelry shops.

The northernmost key in Islamorada, Plantation Key, is the perfect place to start your shopping extravaganza. Boutiques and specialty stores with a waterfront boardwalk await you at Casa Mar Village. Meander along and enjoy the view at this colorful collection of seaside shoppes - do a



paddleboard demo or purchase fresh caught fish from the seafood market.

A bit further south, still on Plantation Key, you'll enjoy the waterfront, Bahamas-style shopping experience at Old Conch Harbor where souvenirs and decorative items are offered in the open air market. Plantation Key is also home to several unique galleries located at MM 88.8 oceanside featuring original acrylics, stained glass art and jewelry, pottery and bronze sculptures. The Rain Barrel, a quaint respite for travelers, is where you'll find "Betsy" the giant lobster, a favorite photo stop, as well as an artisans' cove of souvenir and gift shops, a pottery studio and original art galleries.

Travel over Windley Key and enter Upper Matecumbe Key. Many of the shops here stretch along a walkable section known as the

Morada Way Arts District, where the streets come alive on the third Thursday of each month for the evening Walkabout. Oneof-a-kind jewelry stores, galleries and boutiques line a breezy expanse of the island on the oceanside.

On the bayside you'll be tempted by handmade island-style driftwood

clocks, amazing underwater acrylic masterpieces, brilliant fused glass, and tropical inspired paintings in an array of galleries. Also, on the bayside don't miss the Wildlife Gallery at MM 82.2 where you'll find exquisite wood sculptures, handmade circle hook pendants and life-like nature inspired paintings.

The lush tropical landscape of Upper Matecumbe Key is also dotted with unique stand-alone shops and clothing boutiques offering everything for the tourist, the homemaker and the outdoor adventurer in your life.

Indian Key Fill, bordered by our famous turquoise waters, marks the transition still further south to our fourth island, Lower Matecumbe Key, where the seaside atmosphere takes you back to a simpler time at Robbie's Marina, An unusual blend of local art, conch crafts, jewelry and collectibles fill the Old Florida style shops and stands you'll find here.

Islamorada's history spans more than 3,000 years and represents a fascinating story of nature's power and human courage in an island paradise. The Matecumbe Historical Trust is a non-profit organization dedicated to the education, history and preservation of the Florida Keys; free information is available by calling or visiting online.

The Trust created the Heritage Monument Trail: Markers and descriptive plagues are located throughout the islands marking sites of historical interest, and a colorful self-guided tour brochure is available, mapping the locations of the markers and giving a brief history of each. The Florida Keys Overseas Highway, from Mile Marker 110 to Mile Marker 0, was designated All-American Road in October 2009. The Keys highway is the only All-American Road in Florida. It's the highest recognition possible under the National Scenic Byways program established by the U.S. Congress in 1991. Only 30 other roadways in the nation have earned the prestigious title.

It's been called "the Highway That Goes to Sea," "the most spectacular highway in the U.S." and even "the Road to Paradise." It's the kind of road that not only gets you some place but also takes you somewhere, sealing its reputation as a destination

unto itself. And the only place where you can dip your toes in the Atlantic Ocean then walk across the road and dip your toes in the Gulf of Mexico.


