Stone Crab Claws are a very popular Florida seafood. These crabs have the unusual ability to regrow their claw when harvested by a trapper (only taking the largest claw). Stone crabs can be served hot or cold and pair perfectly with a creamy mustard dip. Stone crab season is October 15 - May 1.



Florida Spiny Lobsters are known for their sweet, tender meat. They're delicious grilled or baked. The official lobster season is August 6 - March 31.



Key Lime Pie is a favorite dessert for locals and tourists, made from Key lime juice, egg yolks and sweetened condensed milk. Key lime trees are found throughout the Florida Keys. Key limes are more tart and aromatic than the more common Persian limes. Key lime juice is pale yellow.



Fish and Shrimp Tacos are a natural pairing with the huge variety of local fish and Key West pink shrimp available. Delicious a must try !



Conch Fritters are a traditional Bahamian recipe that is made with conch, a wonderful shellfish that is delicious but very hard to find. 

Islamorada Plants and Trees



Royal Poinciana

Some say this is the world's most colorful tree with fern-like leaves and flamboyant display of scarlet or orange-red flowers, often called the "fire tree." It is a fantastic shade tree because of its tall but elegant, wide-spreading umbrella-like canopy.

Bougainvillea

Nothing is more breathtaking than a bougainvillea in full bloom with its spectacular color. This thorny ornamental bush has colorful flowers in pink, magenta, purple, red, orange, white or yellow, and the colorful petals are actually leaves called bracts.





Gumbo Limbo

Comically referred to as the "Tourist Tree" because its bark is dark red and peeling like the skin of sunburnt tourists. One of the most hurricane-resistant trees, they were planted to serve as wind protection.

Key Lime

Best known as the flavoring ingredient in Key Lime pie, this citrus species is a shrubby tree with many thorns. Its fruit is in a class all its own and ranges in size from ping -pong to golf ball.





Palm Trees

Palm trees are associated with sun, sand, vacations and the relaxed lifestyle in the Florida Keys. There are about 2,600 species of palm trees, almost all of which can be grown in Florida.

Hibiscus

These eye-catching flowers attract butterflies, bees and hummingbirds. They are used to make tea and other beverages, and also represent nations as the national flower of several countries.



Tabebuia

Primarily used for lumber, these trees are best known for their showy vibrant yellow flowers which look like trumpets and are an important source of nectar for hummingbirds and bees.
