"What Floaties Your Boat?"

RULES

1. Have fun! Be safe! There is no fee to participate.
2. A parent or guardian of each participant must fill out a registration form and sign a waiver of liability/hold harmless agreement, which will be given to you upon your arrival at the race.
3. Participants shall be 10 years of age or younger and must be strong swimmers.
4. Any inflatable may be used as long as it is not dangerous. You may bring a floatie from home or there will be a limited number for sale at the event. No motor of any kind is permitted.
5. Registration begins at 10:00 a.m. on race day. An inflation station will be available.
6. Awards will be made at the discretion of the race committee.
7. Racing will commence at 12:30 pm in brackets drawn at random. There will be a beach start and then participants must circle the buoy offshore (from the left or the right) and then return to the beach.
 - 7.1 Classes: If there are sufficient entries, participants may be divided into age or "floatie" type or size categories.
8. No water balloons or other litter may be thrown.
9. Awards ceremony will follow shortly after racing concludes.
10. The rules may be changed at any time in the interest of safety, enjoyment or the race committee's whim, to enhance the enjoyment of the event.
